Summary

Please provide a compelling summary description of your book in each of the following lengths. This is your "elevator pitch":

- One sentence.
- One paragraph.
- One half-page.

Target Market

Identify your primary and secondary audiences, including specific demographic information (external characteristics; Who is your reader?) and psychographic information (internal motivations; Why will they want to buy your book?). How will this book help them?

Table of Contents

Number and title your chapters.

Chapter Summaries

Write a concise one-paragraph summary of each chapter. This gives us an idea of how you'll structure the book, and where you'll take readers.

Author Biography

Tell us about yourself. Include your qualifications and motivations for writing this particular book, and explain your current platform, sphere of influence, and built-in audience.

Platform & Promotion ideas

Tell us how you will promote your book. Please include relevant data, such as email list, social media followers, media experience, and pertinent statistics whenever possible. Discuss the marketing/publicity venues you are able to personally pursue, including speaking opportunities, influencer connections for endorsements or interviews, etc.

Comparable Works

Research and provide other books in your genre/subject area:

- List 3-5 books that will directly compete with yours. (Focus on books that seem to have performed well, but don't just list the mega-bestsellers, as that would be unrealistic.)
- Include title, author, publisher, year, number of pages, any special features, and retail price.
- "It's like *this*, but different *in this way*" Explain how your book is similar and how it is distinct from each of these other books—what are you offering that is new to the discourse on this subject?

Writing Sample

Include three chapters from your working manuscript. They do not have to be consecutive, but we do request Chapter 1 be included so we can see how you "take the stage." Other chapters should provide a good example of the book's main themes, ethos, and execution.
